♥ Sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Glendora, the 5th annual GUSD **Elementary School Science Bowl** was held on May 5, 2014 at Sellers Elementary School. As reported by Greg Gillham, the science bowl is a science competition between the 5th grade science classes of the 5 elementary schools in the GUSD, Cullen, La Fetra, Sellers, Stanton and Sutherland. Each school holds their own competition and then selects a team of 3 plus an alternate to send to the science bowl.

The funds that Kiwanis provides go to purchase the school name plaque that is put on the perpetual championship trophy that stays at the winning school for the year. The funds also provide the medals given to each of the first 3 place team members. Each member of the 1st and 2nd place teams receives a monetary award that we encourage be added to his or her college fund. 1st place \$50.00 to La Fetra Elementary and 2nd place \$20.00 to Stanton Elementary. Also each student and science teacher from all 5 schools receive a 2014 Science Bowl T-shirt with the Kiwanis International logo on the back. The competition is much like the T.V. show Jeopardy™, with 5 questions ranging from 100 to 500 points in each of 4 science categories. The students from La Fetra Elementary were victorious with a total score of 20,400 points. **CONGRATULATIONS !!!!!**

Former DHS Key Club Members Visit Duarte Kiwanis Club

The Duarte Kiwanis Club was in for a big surprise at a recent meeting. Two Kiwanis Club members, Danielle and Zach Steiner, from Dinuba, California (near Fresno) came to visit. It turns out that Danielle grew up in Duarte, attended DHS and is a former Key Club Member – so they decided to bring an “interclub” to the Duarte meeting.



Hope for Kids Grant Provided to National Guard Member

Maruska Moore was an excellent advocate for National Guard members and their families in her role as Family Assistance Center Specialist right in the Azusa National Guard office. Maruska had worked with the Duarte Kiwanis Club in the past in planning the family holiday



party for the Guard unit. At a recent meeting, Maruska had learned about the Cal Nev Ha Kiwanis Foundation “Hope for Kids” grant. The goal of the Hope for Kids grant is to prevent homelessness for families with children.

There are many stories of vets coming back from deployment and being unable to find jobs and losing their homes. Maruska was instrumental in helping prevent this for one local National Guard member. Mersadi Perry heard about the grant, completed the required documents and shared her ongoing employment, now with Boeing, with the Duarte Kiwanis Club. Mersadi is a single mom with a two-year-old son, Jeremiah. She found a landlord willing to work with her until she got on her feet. At a recent Duarte Kiwanis Meeting, Mersadi

received a \$1500.00 check for her landlord, through the Hope for Kids program, to cover that first three months of rent. This will allow her to sign a lease with her landlord. Mersadi shared her story at the meeting, including the fact that she is now working in the security office at Boeing and will be getting a promotion as well.

Duarte Kiwanis Hears About State Funding & Local School Accountability Plan

How many of our citizens understand the key change that has taken place in State Funding of our local schools? The Duarte Kiwanis Club now has a much better understanding. Joilyn Campitiello District Ed Leader21 Coordinator did an excellent job in outlining the new criteria for funding as well as sharing DUSD’s initial LCAP draft plan. Joilyn is meeting with a number of organizations and groups to solicit input on the plan and incorporate suggestions from parents, teachers and the public at large.

Duarte has an excellent graduation rate from Duarte High School – in excess of 98% - and their plan is to maintain that rate and expand graduates on the college track completing those required classes. The plan also outlines how the District expects to improve and expand opportunities for English learners, children in the Foster Care system and those participating in the free or reduced cost lunch program. All

in all a great plan for all Duarte’s kids.
