On Sunday, October 6, Division 35 held its LTG Installation at the Monrovia Restaurant, in the City of Monrovia. The turnout was great.

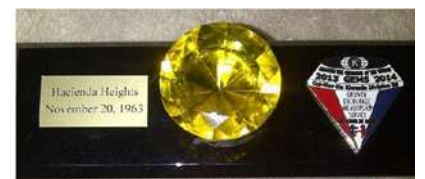
