
Kiwanis Club of Monrovia reports on their Second Annual Auction that took place the night of Nov. 8 at the Monrovia Tennis Club. Per Les Peterson: "We invite various members of our community (lots of Rotarians) and their spousal units to enjoy an evening of free liquid refreshments, a barbecue steak dinner (with all the trimmings...baked potato, tossed salad, fruit salad, rolls and butter and dessert) and auction. After dinner we have the live auction of items our members have donated. Everything from UCLA/USC gift baskets, use of a vacation home for a week end or up to a week, other items included gift certificates to local restaurants, Rose Parade seat tickets, police ride along, etc. Why, even our Rotarian friends gave us the use of a condo in Laughlin, NV, also one of their members gave us a certificate for an airport shuttle service to auction off. We had twenty three separate live auction items. We also held a silent auction with five items too. Our live auction raised over \$8,000 [updated figure] in about 1 1/2 hours, close to 85 folks attended this year's event."

Prior to the above event, reports Don Yost, "Monrovia Kiwanis Club members, Don Yost & John Andersen, helped out the Monrovia Police Department as volunteers on Halloween working on Parent Patrol.
